



The Future Hall of Famers Education Program: By the Numbers

The Future Hall of Famers education program aims to inspire as many Nova Scotia youth as possible each year, and to make the program as accessible as possible to all students:

- In past years, the Hall of Fame has presented to over 75 schools, camps, and other youth groups per year, reaching 10,000-15,000 students in all regions of Nova Scotia
- Since construction on the new facility began, the Hall of Fame has provided award-winning virtual presentations to thousands of students
- 200-300 classes, totalling 5,000+ students, watch each virtual session live, with more watching the recording
- The Hall of Fame continues to offer in-person presentations to Nova Scotia day camp groups, partner with other local museums to provide educational content, and host activities at the annual Sport Fair in Halifax
- Hundreds of curriculum connections are available in the Future Hall of Famers learning activities for grades Primary to 9, all of which are accessible online, and the program is currently undergoing a full redesign to meet new Nova Scotia curriculum needs
- All education programming is offered free of charge

Special donations from Fox Harb'r Invitational participants paid for a new van (pictured below) and much more, allowing the Hall of Fame to easily visit schools, camps, and other youth groups across the province.
