

Official Raffle Rules and Conditions:

Halftime 50-50 (The Raffle) – Nova Scotia Sport Hall of Fame (NSSHF)

OFFICIAL RULES: By participating, entrants agree to be bound by these Official Rules and by the decisions of the NSSHF which shall be binding and final as to all matters related to the Raffle. The Raffle is operated under Provincial Lottery License No. AGD-353136-25 and is subject to all applicable federal, provincial and local laws.

PROCEEDS: All proceeds of the Raffle will benefit NSSHF, and the participating heritage organizations.

PRIZES:

ELIGIBILITY TO ENTER: During the dates and times and other details specified below, Raffle tickets are available for purchase by anyone regardless of their residence if tickets are purchased in person at the game.

Purchaser must be located in Nova Scotia. All sales for a draw will end on Tuesday at approximately 7:30p.m. each week. At the night of the draw, a potential winner will be selected from the eligible entries.

Any direct employees of the Nova Scotia Sport Hall of Fame, or any other people involved in the conduct and management of the Raffle are not allowed to purchase tickets.

PURCHASING RAFFLE ENTRIES: The following prices and corresponding “ticket numbers” are available for purchase: 5 numbers for \$10, 20 numbers for \$20, 100 numbers for \$50 and 200 numbers for \$100

The winning ticket is drawn electronically by a TAP 50:50 representative through a random number generator at the Halifax Forum Super Bingo on Tuesday evenings around 7:30 pm. The winner does not need to be present at the event to claim the prize.

DETERMINATION OF OFFICIAL WINNER: NSSHF shall have the sole discretion to determine whether each potential winner is an official winner of a Prize (an “Official Winner”). NSSHF decisions concerning the identity of all Official Winners shall be final and binding. To become an Official Winner: (1) a Potential Winner must be eligible to participate in the Raffle under these Official Rules and must not be in violation of these Official Rules as determined in NSSHF sole judgment; (2) that potential winner must claim the Prize by the deadline specified above; and (3) the potential winner must satisfy the NSSHF that they are the rightful holders of the winning ticket number.

The potential winner must provide his/her name, address and phone number with picture identification to claim the Prize. A scan of a valid provincial or federal photo identification card (i.e., driver’s license, firearm possession permit, passport, etc.) is acceptable. If it is determined that a potential winner has not satisfied the NSSHF that they are an Official Winner or otherwise

are eligible to receive the Prize, the NSSHF will make best efforts to select another potential winner from amongst those eligible entrants for that draw. However, if this is not feasible, the Prize will be donated to the NSSHF, with the approval of the relevant provincial lottery commission.

In all cases where the Prize has not been awarded within 30 days of the original draw date, the Prize will be donated to the NSSHF again pending the approval of the relevant provincial lottery commission.

AWARD OF PRIZE(S) TO OFFICIAL WINNER(S): A Prize will be awarded to the potential winner who has been designated by NSSHF as an Official Winner.

GENERAL CONDITIONS: The Released Parties (defined below under “RELEASE OF LIABILITY”) are not responsible for: (1) entries which are stolen, lost, damaged, illegible, given away or no longer in the purchaser’s possession, (2) entries that have been or may have been tampered with or re-sold in violation of these Official Rules; (3) entries or payments that are delayed, misdirected, undelivered, not fully captured, or garbled as a result of any failure or problem whatsoever with the availability, functionality, operability or use of any network, server, ISP, website, computer, telephone, cable or satellite modem or connection, hand held mobile device or any other computer equipment or connection, whether or not caused by site users, tampering, hacking, or by viruses, worms, or malfunctions affecting a network, server ISP or any equipment or programming used in or associated with the Raffle; (4) any other errors of any kind, whether human, typographical, printing, mechanical, or electronic in nature, which relate to or are connected with the Raffle (collectively, as described in clauses (1) through (4), “Errors”), including without limitation Errors in Raffle-related materials or in the administration of the Raffle, such as Errors in processing entries, identifying potential winners, determining Official Winners, or announcing or delivering Prizes; or if any portion of the Raffle is compromised, in the Rivalry Series’ sole judgment, by a virus, worm, bug, non-authorized human intervention or other causes which, in the NSSHF sole judgment, corrupt or impair the administration, security, fairness or proper play of the Raffle, or the proper submission or capture of entries (collectively, a “Compromising Event”), then the NSSHF reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to suspend, modify or terminate the Raffle, and to select winners from all eligible, non-suspect entries received before the known occurrence or discovery of such a Compromising Event. All entry purchases shall be final, and no refunds or replacements will be issued by the NSSHF. The NSSHF has the sole and final decision on the admissibility of entries and the determination of an Official Winner.

RELEASE OF LIABILITY: Entrants, by participating in the Raffle, agree that the NSSHF and Tap 50:50, each of their respective parents, affiliates, subsidiaries, partners, and advertising and promotion agencies, and all of their respective officers, directors, employees, representatives, shareholders, committee members, consultants and agents (collectively, the “Released Parties”) will have no liability whatsoever for, and shall be held harmless by entrants against, any liability

for injuries, losses, cost, expenses or damages of any kind, including damages for death, personal injury, property damage.
